The Hon. Wes Sheridan was elected to the Prince Edward Island Legislature on May 28, 2007, as MLA for Kensington-Malpeque. He was subsequently appointed by Premier Robert Ghiz as Provincial Treasurer; Minister Responsible for the Public Service Commission; Minister Responsible for the PEI Lending Agency; and also Minister Responsible for the PEI Harness Racing Commission.

Mr. Sheridan graduated with an Economics Degree from Dartmouth College, in Hanover, New Hampshire, in 1982.
